

champagne

Dom Pérignon R10 960
The luminous sweetness of tropical fruit – green mango, melon, pineapple – instantly shines. It then cedes to more temperate notes, the tingle of orange zest, the mist of a mandarin orange. The wine breathes, revealing its freshness. The bloom after the rain.

Dom Pérignon Luminous SQ
The fruit is majestic. Ripe, fleshy and profound. Beyond the richness and a certain voluptuousness is a strong impression of consistency that prevails. The wine’s power is remarkably restrained. The various sensations – silky, salty, sappy, bitter and briny – converge and persist.

Krug Grande Cuvée R10 120
A blend of around 120 wines from ten or more different vintages and three grape varieties. Krug Grande Cuvée’s exceptional finesse, expressed through its subtle bubbles are the result of resting for at least another six years in Krug’s cellars.

Louis Roederer Cristal 750ml R17 930
Cristal is a remarkably balanced and refined champagne whose length is inimitable. It has a silky texture and fruity aromas, complemented by a powerful mineral quality with white fruit and citrus notes.

Armand de Brignac Brut Gold (Ace of Spades) R17 000
It is elaborated from a blend composed of 40% Pinot Noir, 40% Chardonnay and 20% Meunier and sourced from three different vintages. This iconic champagne was created by Maison CATTIER, but its fame comes from the rapper JAY-Z who bought the brand for the US market, aimed at the stars.

Armand de Brignac Blanc de Blancs (Ace of Spades) SQ
The first aromas of lightly buttered, baked pastry are followed by notes of pear, hazelnut and a hint of gingerbread. On the palate, flavours of exotic fruits such as guava, gooseberry and peach are complemented by sweet spice notes of cinnamon and vanilla. Fresh, mineral finish. Beautifully paired with carpaccio of shellfish or scallops, sashimi, grilled sea bass or a light cheese.

champagne

G.H.Mumm Brut Grand Cordon R2 145
A long ageing provides additional flavours of vanilla, roasted nuts and a hint of toast.

G.H.Mumm Grand Cordon Rosé R2 300
Notes of fresh summer berries with hints of caramel and vanilla.

Moët & Chandon Brut Impérial NV R1 970
Revealing apple, pear and yellow peach, honey, floral nuances and elegant blonde notes.

Moët & Chandon Ice Impérial Rosé R2 495
A glowing pink with notes of red berry and summer fruit. A harmonious balance of fruitiness and freshness.

Veuve Clicquot Brut Yellow Label R2 270
Pale gold, with lovely bubbles and flavours of lemon, grapefruit, ripe apple, almond and toasted bread.

Veuve Clicquot RICH R2 910
Lightly sweet with fresh citrus and floral notes and a silky finish.

Veuve Clicquot Brut Rosé R2 640
Flavours of raspberry, toast, orange peel and ground ginger.

Laurent-Perrier Cuvée Rosé R4 240
A fresh and sharp attack for this supple and rounded wine. On the palate, it offers the sensation of plunging into a basket of freshly picked red berries.

Laurent-Perrier La Cuvée R1 980
The wine’s complexity is expressed in successive notes such as those of vine peach and white fruit. A perfect balance between freshness and delicacy with fruity flavours very present on the finish.

Laurent-Perrier Harmony Demi-Sec R2 000
A brilliant golden yellow colour. The nose is intense and rich, featuring notes of dried fruit such as almonds and hazelnuts, alongside toasted or grilled aromas.

sommelier’s menu



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white blend

Creative Block 2 **R392**
Aromas of gooseberry, lime and white peach are most prominent on the nose, with subtle hints of fynbos. The palate offers blackcurrant leaves and a touch of white asparagus, ending on a long, structured mineral finish.

sauvignon blanc

Springfield Life from Stone **R367**
Life from Stone derives its name from the incredibly rocky soils in which it is grown. Every year the vineyard battles against nature in order to produce highly concentrated, powerful wines with a flinty, mineral character true to the quartz rock in which it is grown. Monumental human effort was required to plant the vines – implements.

Iona **R502**
Beautiful purity of limes and ripe gooseberry, with tropical, floral and fine herbal notes, ruby grapefruit and white pear drop on the finish. This is cool climate Sauvignon Blanc – vibrant, mineral, elegant, balanced and delicate, with a long, layered and complex finish.

Spier 21 Gables **R599**
Fresh grassiness with bell pepper, passion fruit, green fig leaves and gooseberry. The palate is concentrated and richly textured with a fresh, green finish.

chardonnay

Hamilton Russell **R1 899**
A tight, mineral wine with prominent pear and lime fruit aromas and flavours are brought beautifully into focus by a tight line of bright natural acid and a long, dry minerality. An elegant, yet textured and intense wine with a strong personality of both place and vintage.

chenin blanc

Spier 21 Gables **R774**
Soft aromas of dried apricots and ripe tropical fruit, with an oak and vanilla undertow on the nose. On the palate, there’s good acidity and rounded rich flavours of white flesh peaches, almond paste and creaminess.

chenin blanc

Ken Forrester The FMC **R2 107**
A careful selection of up to ten harvests through the same vineyard – choosing the bunches at their peak, naturally fermented in French oak about 50% new and aged for a year in barrel on the lees. A tight, mineral wine with prominent pear and lime fruit aromas and flavours are brought beautifully into focus by a tight line of bright natural acid and a long, dry minerality. An elegant, yet textured and intense wine with a strong personality of both place and vintage.

rosé

Creation Rosé **R343**
Exquisitely perfumed with the come-hither bouquet of a Madame Meilland rosé, blending with the freshness of sun-kissed berries. Profoundly chic yet playful on the palate: lush ripe raspberry laced with evocative hints of dried apple; racy white pepper flirting with the tiniest scoop of honey.

red blend

Vilafonté Series M **R2 957**
Savoury charcuterie and sweet baking spices give way to fragrant, zesty bergamot and jasmine tea. Seductively well-articulated fruit notes of ripe mulberry, blackberry and red currants are complemented by hints of star anise and dried mandarin rind.

Meerlust Rubicon **R1 400**
Very youthful colour, deep and dense with almost purple hue. Quintessential Rubicon nose with violets, ripe plum, cedar wood, fennel, and intense spiciness. Typical liquorice notes also evident on the nose. Still young and intense, the palate is full bodied, structured but packed with fresh dark fruit and rounded tannins and seamlessly integrated oak.

Boekenhoutskloof Chocolate Block **R665**
Juicy red & black fruit seasoned with fresh herbs, fynbos & earth.’ – Platter’s Guide, 4(95/100) Boysenberry and dark cherry dominate an inviting nose, with gentle scents of violets and rose petals and intriguing whiffs of exotic spice.*

Groot Constantia Gouverneurs Reserve Red **R1 350**
This Cabernet Sauvignon-driven blend shows black currant, dark chocolate and graphite on the nose, while generous use of new oak adds cinnamon and cedar wood aromas to the nose. On the palate the wine shows beautiful intensity and the time in barrel adds a hint of vanilla to the palate. Firm tannin promises good ageing potential.

Cabernet Sauvignon

Thelema **R835**
Complex and stylish, with aromas of blackcurrant leaf and coffee bean which progresses into a palate that’s structured and racy with hints of leather, dark chocolate and sweet blackberry. The firm tannins yield a gripping mouthfeel from the first sip through to the long lingering finish.

David Finlayson **R475**
David Finlayson Cabernet Sauvignon has a fresh, minty herbaceousness backed by mocha vanilla oak. Firm structured tannins and a long finish on the palate show good ageing potential.

pinot noir

Creation **R702**
The wine is bright and shiny, resembling a polished garnet. Intensely fragrant, the bouquet combines a bevy of seductive red berries with whiffs of vanilla and wood spice. These follow through on the elegant palate where the refined flavours of raspberry and the earthiness of shiitake mushroom are supported by supple tannins.

Hamilton Russell **R1 936**
Hamilton Russell Vineyards Estate Pinot Noir has a beautiful mix of wild red and dark fruit aromas with a floral hint of violets. Red cherries combined with a back-note of dark cassis, and pomegranate combined with dark plums.

A typical spicy character shows, with hints of cinnamon, nutmeg and clove. This is complemented by subtle fennel and salted liquorice aromas with iron and wet clay. The palate is long and vibrant with characteristic taut athleticism and tannin line.
